**PERFORMANCE FACT SHEET
 PHYSICAL THERAPY AIDE/MASSAGE THERAPIST**

² “Students Available for Graduation” is the number of students who began the program minus the number of students unavailable for graduation, which means those students who have died, been incarcerated, or called to active duty.

³ “Graduates” is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length.

⁴ “Completion Rate” is the number of graduates divided by the number of “Students Available for Graduation”.

⁵ “150% Completion Rate” is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 101-150% of the program length divided by the number of “Students Available for Graduation”.

⁶ “150% Graduates” is the number of students who completed the program within 101-150% of the published length of the program.

³ “Graduates Available for Placement” is the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment. Graduates unavailable for employment means graduates who after graduation die, become incarcerated, called to active duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an accredited or BPPE approved institution.

⁴ “Graduates Employed in the Field” means graduates who are gainfully employed in a single position for which the institution represents the program prepares its graduates within six months after a student completes the applicable educational program.

⁵ “Placement Rate” is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field divided by the number of graduates available for employment.
